Thanks to our reviewers in 2024

We thank again this year everyone who has participated in our Journal with the work of reviewing the published articles.

A medical journal largely depends on its reviewers, and their work has been absolutely exceptional. The quality of the work is not easily measured, but some indicators can provide an indirect measure: in 2024, 65 reviewers collaborated, and 226 articles were reviewed, a tremendous increase from 179 in 2023.

All articles were reviewed by at least two reviewers, each at least twice per reviewer (the initial review and the reassessment after corrections) – many were reviewed more than this. It's a lot of work!
